MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE COUNCIL HELD ON 17 DECEMBER 2018 AT THE
MEMORIAL HALL, NYNEHEAD

18/119 There were no Declarations of Interest.

18/120 The Minutes of the meeting held on 19 November 2018 were approved and signed as a
correct record.

18/121 There were no Matters Arising.

18/122 Police Report.

- (i) In the absence of PCSO Baker, the Clerk read out a report that she had received. There had been a road traffic incident reported on the Chipley Road, Nynehead. There was an incident of youths riding Moped type vehicles on fields around Nynehead. The PCSO had recently attended Oake, Nynehead and Bradford School after a report of a near miss with a pedestrian and vehicle and are deploying a speed gun in the area.

18/123 Rights of Way.

- (i) Mr Joe Frost, Parish Paths Liaison Officer was unable to attend the meeting but had reported to the Clerk that all was well with the footpaths, just very muddy after all the recent rain.

18/124 Highways.

- (i) The Clerk had received correspondence from Somerset Highways Dept. regarding the Distribution of rock salt. This would no longer be free to Parish Councils but was available at a cost.
- (ii) The condition of the road surface at the junction of the Poole road with Nynehead Road was discussed and the Clerk was instructed to contact SCC Highways to ask when the re-surfacing would take place as previously stated. The members also asked the Clerk to request that the gullies be flushed out along the Nynehead Road.

18/125 Planning Matters.

- (iii) To consider prior notification 26/18/0013/CP for the change of use of storage and distribution building, (Class B8), to 1 No. residential dwellings, (Class C3), at Perry Farm, East Nynehead. No further comments.
- (iv) To consider prior notification 26/18/0014/CP for the change of use of storage and distribution building, (Class B8), to 2 No. residential dwellings, (Class C3), at Perry Farm, East Nynehead. No further comments.

18/126 Parish Council Administration

- (i) The condition of the bench situated outside of the Memorial Hall and belongs To the Parish, was discussed. It was decided to defer this item until the summer months as the bench is too wet to consider renovation at the present.

- (ii) The members authorised the booking of training sessions with SALC at a cost of £90.00 for the new Clerk. These will commence in February 2019.
- (iii) Mr Sparks informed the Council members that Nynehead Court are organising a village Fete to take place on 29th June 2019 and to be held within their grounds. Money raised is intended to be donated to the Wellington Monument restoration fund and other local groups. There will be a meeting to organise the event on 9th January 2019 at the Court.
- (iv) The Clerk reported that the awareness seminar held in November for the Community Public Access Defibrillator was attended by 32 parishioners and was very successful. The Clerk was instructed to research further the VET system for discussion at the next meeting.
- (v) The members agreed on the dates of the meetings for 2019. These will all continue to be held on the 3rd Monday of the month with a holiday in August. The Clerk was instructed to publish these on the Nynehead.org website.
