4.00 pm onwards	Transfer to the Memorial Hall. The Court will be running a shuttle bus service between the Court and the Hall.
4.30 pm	Village photograph at the Hall
5.00 pm	Entertainment by NADS, directed by Kathy Boyd
5.30 pm	'Street Party' in the Hall

There will be a car park available at the Court.

Raffle prizes, if possible, should be given to Hilary Hooper before the 11th June. The proceeds of raffle ticket sales will be split between the Court and to help cover the costs of the day.

Can anyone with a flag and/or bunting please put it up from Monday 6th June. Anyone who has offered to help with bunting at the Hall will be contacted about when this will be done.

The Club bar will be open from the late afternoon onwards.

I am pleased to report some good news regarding the Playing Field. We have now received payment for the sale of land to Kinvara, this land was previously leased. Also, and more importantly, the boundary issue which has burdened various committees for years has now been resolved, with the Playing Field receiving money for the sale of land and compensation to cover previous legal expenses.

Last September the committee carried out a survey of the village to assess requirements for the future. The responses provided ideas for improvements, however a large number of forms were not returned.

This is a good facility for the village but it needs support to continue.
