FLY TIPPING

Fly tipping around the village was discussed at the Parish Council meeting in August and the following paragraphs from Taunton Deane's website give further details.

You can report cases of fly tipping by calling Customer Services on 01823 356356 or by using the online form on the Council's website - www.tauntondeane.gov.uk/services>services directory>report flytipping.

Fly tipping is a crime. If you witness somebody dumping rubbish:

- Stay safe and never confront the offenders.
- Take down as much detail as possible day, date, time and location.
- Note any vehicle details make, colour and registration.
- Record offenders' details how many, brief description and what they were doing.

All this information can help with a prosecution.

If you discover fly tipped waste after it has been left please follow these procedures:

- Don't touch the waste; it could be dangerous, containing syringes or other hazardous substances.
- Do visually inspect the waste; the more information we know about the incident, the more it can help.
- Do take note of its exact location, and whether it is in or near water.
- Do report it immediately.
- Don't disturb the site; there may be evidence that could help to identify offenders and lead to their prosecution.

The Council aims to collect all fly tipping on Council land within five days.
