## **SPEED LIMIT**

### **The introduction of speed restrictions in Nynehead and East Nynehead**

The issue of speeding vehicles in the lanes approaching Nynehead and East Nynehead has been a thorny topic for many years. Many pedestrians and cyclists have complained about feeling vulnerable and endangered when vehicles pass them at speed and, every year, there are a series of, usually minor, road traffic collisions caused by driving too fast. Until now, a 60mph limit has been legal which, clearly, is inappropriate with an increasing volume of traffic travelling through narrow, twisty lanes with neither pavements nor street lighting.

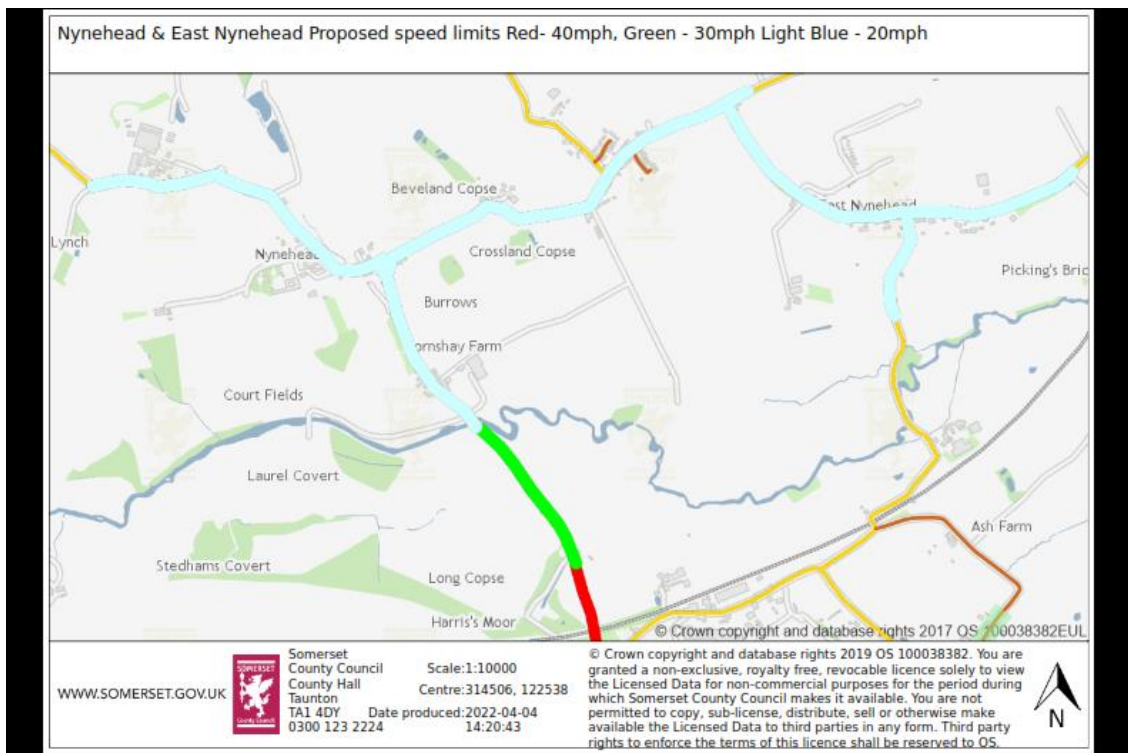
The Parish Council has vigorously pursued this issue with Somerset County Council over the past two years and, although hindered by lockdowns and subsequent backlogs, the speed data collected at various locations confirmed the need for traffic calming measures. The amendments suggested by NPC to the draft plans drawn up by SCC Traffic Management have been accepted and the police have given their support to the proposals. The 40mph restriction at the top of the Nynehead Road (from the proposed extension in connection with the Lidl store) will now be extended to Wharf Cottage where a 30 mph restriction will be introduced. This will reduce to 20mph at the bridge near Hornshay Farm. The map shows where a proposed 20mph zone will come into force in other locations.

It is estimated that the cost of introducing a 20/30mph limit with all associated signs and lines and Traffic Regulation Order will be in the region of £9000. Due to the current high demand in this area, the Traffic

Regulation Order could take between 3-6 months to advertise but work on the detailed design and checks for utility services are underway. There are several other stages still to complete, including a safety audit, the consideration of any objections, the works package preparation and the contractor mobilisation. However, bar any further setbacks, it is reasonable to hope that the speed restrictions will be operational by the end of this year.

The Parish Council is grateful to Kate Brown from SCC Traffic Management for her support with this project and, indeed, to Nynehead Court who has very generously offered to finance a large portion of the costs.
