#### **PARISH COUNCIL**

# **Quarterly Report (June to August 2023)**

Members of the Parish Council are very pleased to see the new 20 mph speed signs popping up along the roads of Nynehead. It is rewarding to see the new signage as this project has been in progress for many, many years. The next step will be to arrange speed monitoring to further enhance the effectiveness of the new speed restrictions.

Residents of Nynehead are asked to help the Parish Council with their concerns over the new Lidl junction on the Nynehead Road. There have been many reports of 'near misses' where cars leaving the roundabout driving along Nynehead Road towards Nynehead have had cars exiting Lidl pull out in front of them. This new Lidl junction is the proposed road for entering and leaving the new Wellington station, housing and industrial areas. If you have experienced any dangerous incidents at this site please report them to: Simon Fox who is the Planning Officer responsible (simon.fox@somerset.gov.uk) with Alex Skidmore of the Highways Department (alex.skidmore@somerset.gov.uk) copied in. The strength of the argument will be influenced by the number of actual examples submitted.

The Annual Governance Statement for 2022/2023, Accounting Statement for the year ending 31st March 2023, Certificate of Exemption - AGAR 2022/2023, and the Annual Return 2022/2023 were all approved by the Parish Council in June and signed by Dr Butterley. These can all be viewed at www.nynehead.org.

The Members are continuing discussions with Somerset Highways over the need for improved signage for the roads that are liable to flooding.

The footpath to Bradford on Tone (Footpath diversion WG14/1) continues to occupy Council time. District Councillor Gwil Wren, Bradford on Tone Councillor Leigh Sidhu and the Clerk met the landowner, Mr James Dalgren and viewed the old bridge, the site for the new footbridge and proposed diversion route on the Nynehead side of the River Tone. There are many complications with the proposed Diversion - it is regarded as too different from the original route, needing permissive paths, Somerset Council's concerns about landowner's rights over the proposed new footbridge, plus unknown objections. Members will continue to work towards the re-opening of this footpath.

After Airband cancelled their presentation to the Parish Council Meeting in June, at very short notice, another date for the presentation will be sought in the autumn. To register your interest for a connection please visit <a href="https://www.airband.co.uk">www.airband.co.uk</a>


